- What is it?** **Spring Rendezvous, Hosted by the Osage Nation District** is a fun-filled, weekend camp for all Scouts from Tiger cubs to Boy Scouts and Venturers. This event will provide a fun opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** This event will be based on a tradition Rendezvous theme with some modern twists to make it interesting
- When & Where?** **Friday, Saturday & Sunday April 21-23, 2017 at the CANEY VALLEY ANTIQUE TRACTOR GROUNDS 4 MILES NORTH OF CANEY KS.**
Check-in begins at 5:30pm April 21. Check out Sunday after Church
- Health Forms?** Parts A & B of the BSA Health Form is required for all Scouts and adults. **Forms must be turned in at check in.** Blank forms **will not** be provided.
- Cost?** **Regular registration by APRIL 18, 2017 is \$10 per Scout, \$10 per Adult.**
- Refunds?** There are no refunds available for this event.
- Food?** **No meals will be provided. Cooking by patrol methods, Saturday supper is pot luck.**
- Supervision?** All units must have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and all adults must have **completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp.** **Please bring a copy of all Adult Youth Protection certification to check-in.** Cub Scouts, Webelos, Boy Scouts and Venturing Scouts all have different camping guidelines. Be advised that your unit must meet the guidelines when at this event.
- Registration?** Event is open to all Units, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide program materials to all youth participants as well as patches. Please register online and pay all fees by the regular price deadline of **April 18th, 2017. No registrations will be accepted after April 18th.** **Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave.** **Registrations and payments for all Quivira Council events are now online and this registration is available through www.quivira.org/Camping webpage link. Once on *Tentaroo select *District Camporees* to continue. Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check (use down arrow for selection).**
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as sickness and accident insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of Quivira Council.
- Camping?** Any camping must be in compliance with BSA camping guidelines. Restrooms and potable water are provided on sight.
