What is it?

Day Camp, Hosted by the Pawnee District is a fun-filled, two-day camp for Cub Scouts of all ages. Each day will provide a fun opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.

Activities?

Join the Scouts on this year's Exploration: Scouts will be building crafts, participating in shooting sports activities (Archery, wrist-rockets and BB gun), nature hikes, and much more.

When & Where?

Friday & Saturday, June 30 & July 1, 2017: Check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. the first day of camp. Camp runs 9-4 each day. The camp will be held at Camp Kanza 10510 S Sterling Rd, Abbyville, KS 67510 (20 min West of Hutchinson).

Health Forms?

Parts A & B of the BSA Health Form is required for all scouts and adults. Forms must be turned in at check in. Blank forms will not be provided.

Cost?

Regular Registration by May 15, 2017 is \$40 per Scout, (Includes T-shirt, cup and patch; T-shirts run small) **\$10 per Adult**. (Includes T-shirt, cup and patch)

Food?

No meals will be provided. Please bring a sack lunch for the members of your pack both days.

Supervision?

All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and all adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please bring a copy of all Adult Youth Protection certification to check-in.

Registration?

Event is open to all Packs, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patches, cups, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches and shirts to adults. Please register online and pay all fees by the regular price deadline of **May 15th, 2017**. Registrants prior to May 15th will be \$40/youth and \$10/adults. All registrations received after May 15th will register at the late rate of \$50/youth and \$20/adults. **No registrations will be accepted after June 16th. Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event.** **Registrations and payments for all Quivira Council events are now online and this registration is available through www.quivira.org/Camping webpage link.** Once on *Tentaroo select *Day Camps* to continue. Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check (use down arrow for selection).

Insurance?

Liability, as well as sickness and accident insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of Quivira Council.

Camping?

Camping is NOT part of the Day Camp, however your Pack may organize a Family Camp at Camp Kanza through the Council Office, call 316-491-2223. Any camping must be in compliance with BSA camping guidelines.
