



# Bug Out!

**2017 SW District Day Camp • June 1-3**

**Enjoy the fun of Day Camp at the beautiful High Park in Derby.**

- What is it?** South Winds Day Camp is a fun-filled, three-day camp for Cub Scouts of all ages. Each day will provide the opportunity for your Scouts to have a new experience, with memories that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** All activities are age appropriate and based on program level, including but not limited to archery, BB-gun target shooting, arts & crafts, awesome wood projects, games, song. There is no swimming this year but we will have activities to get everyone wet, so it's good to dress accordingly. Each boy will be working on advancements and electives toward their next rank. Each person will either need to pack a sack lunch each day or leave the event to eat lunch (many restaurants available), except the 3<sup>rd</sup> day where a lunch will be provided. **Third day is family day where families are welcome** and will also be fed lunch. Each unit will need to provide an accurate count of how many additional family members will be joining for lunch that day.
- When & Where?** **June 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017, High Park located at 2801 E. James, Derby, KS.** Check-in begins at 9:30 a.m. each day of camp. Camp runs 10-3:00 each day. If raining or thundering we will meet at the Derby LDS Stake located at 1409 S. Rock. Alternate activities will take place at that location until it is deemed safe to return outside.
- Supervision?** **All packs MUST have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and all adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp.** Please provide a copy of all Adult Youth Protection cards at check in first day. All Tigers must have an adult partner with them. Adults will help run stations. All parents are welcome on Parent's Day Saturday. Any non-registered adult attending more than parents' day must complete Youth Protection Training, bring a copy of Adult Youth Protection card and complete an adult application with them to camp! **No Exceptions! NO TAG ALONGS** (other non-registered children)
- Registration?** **EVENT IS LIMITED TO 250 YOUTH!!!** Event is open to all Tiger Cub- Arrow of Light Scouts from all Packs, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patches, cups, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches and shirts to adults. Please register online by the early bird deadline of **Saturday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. Registrants prior to April 15<sup>th</sup> will be \$45/ youth and \$10/ adults. All registrations received after April 15<sup>th</sup> will register at the regular rate of \$55/ youth and \$20 /adults. **No registrations will be accepted after April 25<sup>th</sup>. No Phone or email add-ons or registrations will be accepted. Registration is online only. The registration link may be found at <http://www.quivira.org/camping> webpage. Once on \*Tentaroo select *Day Camps* to continue. Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check (use drop down arrow for selection)**  
- Parts A & B of the health forms must be provided for all participants at check in. Parts A & B of the Health form are required. We will not provide forms onsite. Any person without completed health form will not be allowed to take part in the event. **Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave,** with the exception of the 3<sup>rd</sup> day where families are welcome.
- Refunds?** No refunds are available for this event.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.
