Host Unit's participating in this program will be matched with Out-of-Council units in the order in which the request to be a host unit is received.

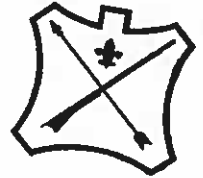
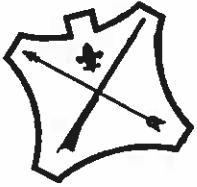
Each Host Unit matched with an Out-of-Council unit will receive recognition for their willingness to participate.
