



**THE LION PILOT PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN:**

Pack \_\_\_\_\_ and the Quivira Council, Boy Scouts of America.

The purpose of the Lion Pilot Program are 1) to test the concept and positive impact on the goals of the BSA on a smaller scale before considering a national launch, and 2) to ensure the program is sustainable and replicable across the nation. To ensure that this pilot program can be used for evaluation purposes, program materials must be used as designed. Changes by unit Lion Guides and others to the program will invalidate the evaluation process. To ensure adherence to the Lion Pilot Program goals, the responsibilities of both the Quivira Council, BSA and the Cub Scout pack are described below.

**Our Pack agrees to:**

- Follow the Lion Pilot program as outlined in the Lion Parent And Leader Guidebook, including the recommendations on fundraising, meeting attendance, and additional activities.
- Recruit and register a unit Lion Guide prior to August Roundtable, whose exclusive role will be to organize the Lion dens in our unit.
- Have the unit Lion Guide attend one of the required training sessions at August 2016 Round Tables.
- Start the Lion Pilot Program with youth recruited at Fall SUFS, 2016.
- Organize Lion dens to only include Kindergarten aged boys (no mixed aged dens).
- Have no fewer than six and no greater than eight youth assigned to each Lion den.\*
- Gather requested information on the Lion Pilot Program and submit to the Quivira Council.
- Submit all advancements earned to the Quivira Council.

**The Quivira Council agrees to:**

- Follow the Lion Pilot Program as outlined in the Lion Parent and Leader Guidebook.
- Assist with collection of data, monitor the overall success of the program and be a resource to district Lion Coordinators.
- Work with each district to train district Lion Coordinators who will assist with collection of data, monitor the overall success of the program and be a resource to unit Lion Guides.
- Provide trainings for unit Lion Guides so they are able to organize and implement the Lion Pilot Program.
- Provide recruitment and marketing materials related to the Lion Pilot Program.
- Work with the Quivira Scout Shop to ensure all Lion Pilot Program related materials, uniforms, and advancements are available for packs. (If available from National)
- Collect and report the required data to the Boy Scouts of America.

*We understand the council reserves the right to remove us from the Lion Pilot Program if we do not meet the above criteria.*
