National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) May 29 - June 3, 2017

Course Overview

This premier Council level co-ed training experience teaches the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what they must **KNOW**, and what they must **DO**. These key elements bring together the **HOW TO's** of Leadership. Your Leadership skills will come alive as you embark on your Quest for the Meaning of Leadership in one of two, week-long course formats:

NYLT or NYLT X-treme

NYLT: Your week will focus on leadership principles located in and around your camp area with excursions throughout the week.

NYLT X-treme: (a limited number of slots will be available) Covers the leadership principles of NYLT and adds physically demanding, high adventure activities for older youth. Weather permitting, opportunities include canoeing, climbing, COPE, rappelling, swimming, and day hikes – which tie together the NYLT leadership experience with *X-treme* fun.

Youth Who May Attend

- **NYLT:** any registered youth 13 years of age or older.
- **NYLT X-treme:** any registered youth 14 years of age or older with a High Adventure Physical and who can pass a BSA "Blue Swimmer" Swim test.
- Boy Scouts must be a First Class Scout and completed ILST.
- Venturing Scouts must have completed Crew Officers Orientation and VLSC.
- Be recommended by their Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor.

Registration

The **NYLT** fee is **\$185**. **NYLT X-treme** fee is **\$195**. The **cut-off date for registration and final fees due is May 1, 2017.**

To register, submit a completed application form along with a *non-refundable* deposit of \$35.00 to the Quivira Council office. Participants will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis until both courses reach capacity. Alternates will be placed on a stand-by list.

The fee covers training materials, food, and recognition items. In addition, you will need to provide your personal camping gear and uniforms. Details will be found in your participant packet located on our council's web site, www.quivira.org.

Award...

NYLT participants who attend all sessions will receive the BSA NYLT patch in recognition of completing the course.

...and Application

Only those completing NYLT can earn the Quivira Council's Silver Tomahawk Award and patch. To earn the Silver Tomahawk Award, with agreement between the home unit Leader and Scout, the youth must demonstrate the leadership skills learned at NYLT; put these skills into practice at their home unit; and accomplish these goals during the six months after the course.



The Silver Tomahawk Award recognizes that the purpose of NYLT is not just to provide a great training adventure and experience for scouts, but also to develop Leaders that serve their Units.

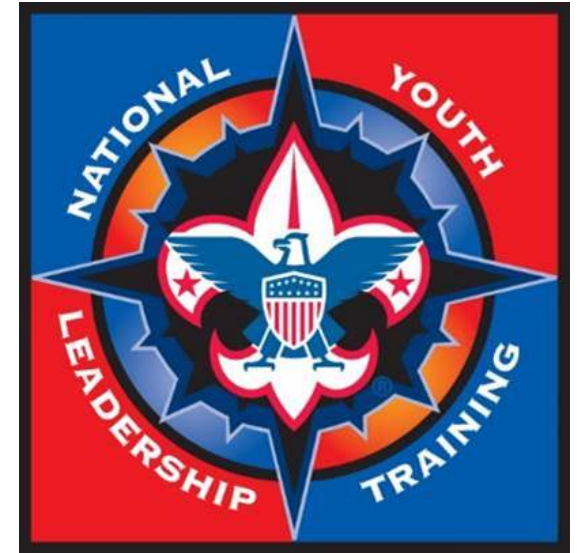
