

Staff will help you with 2 deep in leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines. <u>ALL adults</u> must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please provide a copy of all Adult Youth Protection Cards at check-in the 1st day. <u>ALL Tiger's must have parent partner with them, discount price for Tiger Parent Partners.</u> \*<u>Each person will need to pack a Sack Lunch each day\*</u>.

**YOU MUST LIST RANK!!** Please be sure to list the Rank of youth in Black Pug that the youth will be as of August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**TWILIGHT CAMP IS LIMITED TO 80 Registered Youth & Adult SCOUTS. NO Tag Along's!** Tiger's thru Arrow of Light Scouts, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patch, cup, shirt and program materials to all youth participants as well as patch and shirt to registered adults. <u>Please register online by July 22<sup>nd</sup>, no later than **11:59 pm** for the BEST Camp Fee.</u>

Registrants by July 22<sup>nd</sup> will be \$45.00 per youth and \$15.00 per adults, Tiger Parent \$10. ALL registrations received July 23<sup>rd</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup> will be at the rate of \$55.00 per scout and \$25.00 per all adults. NO registrations will be accepted after July 30th or at Camp as a Walk-In!

Registration is online only! Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check.

When registering you will need to put in Shirt Sizes for both youth and adults. Shirts will be available in the following sizes: T-shirt sizes: Youth MD, Youth LG, Adult SM, Adult MD, Adult LG, Adult XL. Adult XXL, Adult XXXL, Adult XXXL, It is your responsibility to keep track of what sizes you ordered. *No exchanging sizes will be allowed.* 

Health Forms? Parts A & B of the health forms MUST be provided for all participants (youth and adults) at check in. Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave.

There will be NO Refunds available, but you can transfer fees to another Scout on the same registration.

Insurance? Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.

Closed toe/heel shoes only! No Crocs, flip flops, sandals or open toe/heel shoes of any kind! No Spaghetti strap shirts allowed. No exceptions!
