*All participants must provide a signed <u>Quivira Council Covid Waiver Form</u> and <u>Health Forms (Part A & B only)</u> at check-in. Fillable forms may be downloaded on the council website. <u>Masks are to be worn indoors by youth and adults.</u>

*Each Troop must have a minimum of 2 leaders registered for the event in accordance to Youth Protection Guidelines. Adult leaders must have completed Youth Protection Training. Adult leaders will be expected to assist the counselor in checking outside work materials, recording class accomplishments, and maintaining discipline and learning environment. We do not anticipate behavior problems; however, if they occur, the Scout will be excused from class and escorted to an adult with their Troop.

The worksheets will be the only Blue Cards.

The official Boy Scout Field Uniform should be worn to help identify Scouts and leaders.
