What is it?	Cub Scout Day Camp is a weekend program will be a 2 evening (6-9pm) and 2 all-day Friday and Saturday (8am-4pm) that is open to all youth in kindergarten through 5th grade. Prepare yourself for a Norseman themed event.
Activities?	As Norsemen child, they will do the activities and crafts. The twilight activities will have a glow in the dark theme; night archery, glow in the dark bubbles and homemade bouncy balls to name a few of items they will make. All the activities are age appropriate and guided by our well trained and enthusiastic staff. Every scout will need to bring a claw hammer! A cordless drill will help the process (adults only will operate.) Parents be prepared for your young Norseman to bring home a birdhouse, table, or a chair. All depends on their rank. They will also make a peg game, mini catapult, stamp a leather bracelet, make a rope puzzle and play water games.
When & Where?	12-15 July 2023 Big Hill Lake, Overlook side
Supervision?	All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines, and all registered leaders must have completed NEW Youth Protection Training. AOLs must have appropriate unit leadership.
Food?	Bring a sack lunch. Everyone needs to bring something to hold water.
Cost?	Pre-registration Fee is \$65 per scout \$20 per adult. Registrations after June 16, 2023 will be \$75 per scout. Registration fee includes program materials and a patch for all participants. Last day to register June 23, 2023 . Camperships are available for cub scouts.
Refunds?	Refunds are not available, but fees may be transferred to another Scout or Adult under same registration number.
Registration?	Registration is open online on Black Pug – find the link at www.quivira.org – Things to Do. Pre-registration is required for program materials and patches to be provided to all participants. Registration prior to May 1, 2023, is required to guarantee a patch. Event is open to all registered Packs. Online payment is required and may be made by credit card or electronic check. REQUIRED: ALL participants MUST have Parts A&B of the health form Unit Roster is REQUIRED at check-in. This year will have a Trading Post. It will have camp shirts, flashlights, pocketknives, candy, apples, cold drinks, and crafts.
Insurance?	Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered members of the BSA.
