Program Year = Calendar Year

Membership Growth = Youth on 12/31/2024 less Youth on 12/31/2023 is greater than zero

Advancement = (Youth advancing ≥ 1 ranks in Calendar year) / (Youth registered at end of year)

Long Term Campers = (Youth camping) / (Membership on 6/30/2024)

Retention Total = (Youth on Charter renewal 2024) / [(Youth rechartered prior year 2023) + (New Youth) - (Ageout Youth)]

Internet Advancement = tracking of service projects and hours

Leadership = SM, ASM, CC, MC-2
